Rating for one year following surgery

STIFFNESS OR SHOULDER IMMOBILITY DIAGNOSTIC CODE 5200

CRITERIA
Can only lift arm 25 degrees from side
Can only lift arm from 26 degrees to 59 degrees from side
Can only lift arm 60 degrees from side, can reach your mouth and head

LIMITATION OF MOTION OF SHOULDER AND ARM DIAGNOSTIC CODE 5201

CRITERIA
Can only lift arm 25 degrees from side or in front
Can only life arm 45 degrees from side or in front
Can only lift arm 90 degrees from side or in front

IMPAIRMENT OF THE HUMERUS BONE DIAGNOSTIC CODE 5202

CRITERIA
The humeral head is lost causing loss of joint function and inability to stabilize the shoulder (known as a flail shoulder)
Nonunion of the humerus (known as a false flail joint)
Fracture site with mobility (known as a fibrous union)
Frequent episodes of dislocated shoulder, guarding all movements
Infrequent episodes of dislocated shoulder, only guarding movement at shoulder level
Malunion of humerus bone with marked deformity
Malunion of humerus bone with moderate deformity
